If in doubt, contact the supplier



Read these instructions thoroughly before commencing assembly & retain a copy for your reference



Inspect all packages for damage and check that all components ordered are included



Assembly should be undertaken by at least two competent people



Tools required – Tape measure, rubber mallet and drill if wall fixing is required



We recommend products over 2000mm high are fixed to the wall where possible



Caution

During assembly:



Take care when handling heavy items, particularly when lifting or stretching



Wear appropriate clothing protective gloves and footwear are recommended



Build on a suitable level floor surface which is strong enough to support the load



Allow adequate working space and be aware of others working around you



Dispose of packaging materials responsibly

Rules for safe use of shelving:



Please retain these Instructions for reference and ensure that users understand the rules for safe use



Never climb on the structure or stand on the shelves



Do not lean ladders, steps, or other objects against shelving



Always use safety steps to reach high shelves



Load heavy items on the lower shelves and lighter items on the higher shelves



This product is designed for hand loading only



Do not use in damp or wet environments




Ensure that the maximun load carrying capacities are not exceeded



















Insert the other ends of the front and back beams (3) into the second frame just as in step 5.
