If in doubt, contact the supplier



Read this guide thoroughly before commencing assembly and retain for future reference



Before commencing assembly, unpack carefully and check that all components ordered are included



Tools - Wrench (not included)



Caution

During assembly, ensure to:



Take care during assembly and in use, particularly when lifting or stretching & when using tools



Wear appropriate safety clothing



Build on a suitable level floor, which is strong enough to support the load and allow adequate working space



Dispose of packaging materials responsibly

Do not use the tool cabinet for any purpose other than that for which it was designed for



Do not step on the drawer levels



Do not use in damp or wet conditions



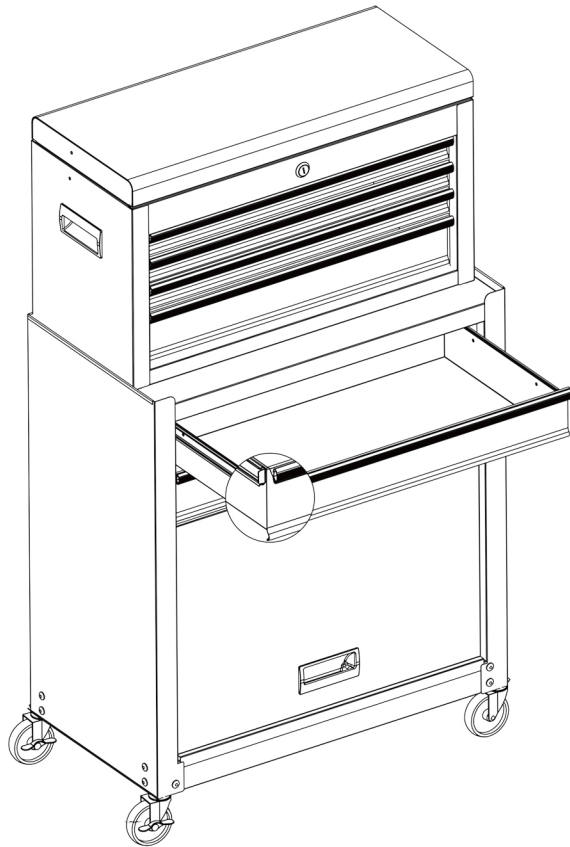
Do not open more than one drawer at the same time

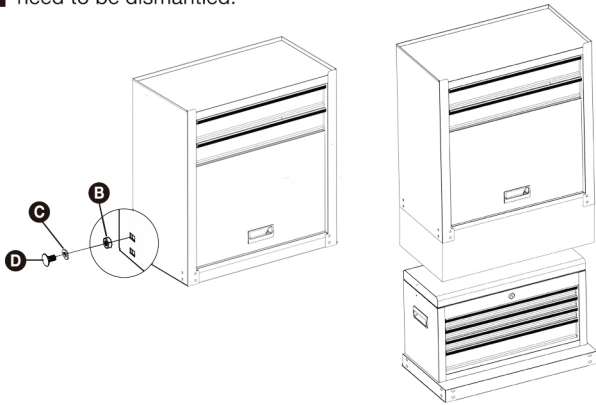

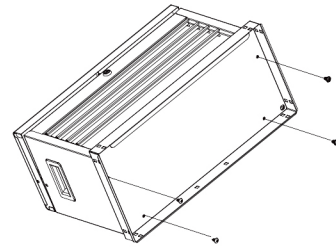

Assembly - BiGDUG 24" Tool Chest & Rollcab Combination

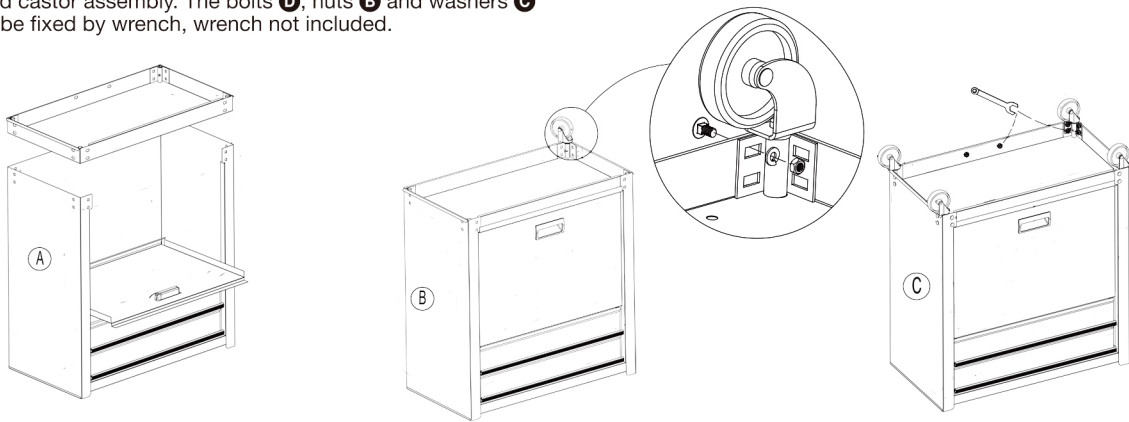
- 1** Lift off the body. The bolts **D**, nuts **B** and washers **C** need to be dismantled.



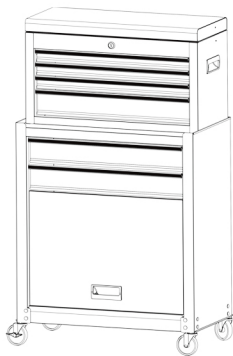
- 2** Remove base. Remove 4 screws from the base and discard the screws.



- 3** Base and castor assembly. The bolts **D**, nuts **B** and washers **C** need to be fixed by wrench, wrench not included.



- 4** Put the tool chest on the top of the roller cabinet.



- 5** Lubricate drawer slides periodically. Hardware (nuts, bolts, screws) tighten periodically.
