



BiGDUG LONGSPAN GARMENT RACKING

ASSEMBLED FRAME

Quantity:

2 per starter bay, 1 per extension bay



(B)

GARMENT RAIL

Quantity:

2 per level



(C)

SAFETY CLIP

Quantity:

2 per beam/rail



(D)

SHELF BEAM (Optional)

Quantity:

2 per level



(E)

CHIPBOARD DECK (optional)

Quantity:

Less than 1900mm wide: 1 per level
1900mm wide or greater: 2 per level

LEVELLING PLATE

Quantity:

1 per foot




During assembly do not tighten bolts until all components are aligned properly, then tighten fully.

If you have any missing components please take note of the part name and contact your supplier.


Longspan Garment Racking is safe when used responsibly. If in doubt, contact the supplier.




1 Position first frame **A** and locate garment rail **B** into holes on frame upright.




2 Using a rubber mallet, knock garment rail **B** fully into place.




3 Attach other end of garment rail **B** into second side frame **A** at the same level.




4 Add a second garment rail **B** to the uprights **A** at the same height and ensure rails are knocked in fully with a rubber mallet.




5 Insert safety clips **C** into the holes at each end of the rails **B** to ensure the rails cannot be removed from the upright.



6 Repeat steps 1 to 5 to add the remaining rails **B** at the required heights.




7 To extend the shelving, add garment rails **B** to the second frame **A** and repeat steps 1 to 5 to add extra rails.




8 If adding a shelf level, repeat steps 1 to 5 to add shelf beams to the frame.



9 Insert chipboard **E** panels into shelf beams ensuring they sit onto the top ledges.



10 When positioning bay, please note that garments will hang outside the frame.



11 Before fixing to the floor, ensure shelving is straight and level. Drill floor to 100mm depth and add levelling plates **F** if needed.

Safety Instructions



Information:

If in doubt, contact the supplier:

- Read this guide before commencing assembly and retain for future reference
- Before commencing assembly, unpack carefully and check that all components ordered are included
- Assembly should be undertaken by a minimum of two competent people
- Tools – Large rubber mallet, metal hammer, drill and 8mm drill bit and a 13mm socket
- Floor fixing is required to ensure stability. If this is not possible, this product must be fixed to the wall.



Caution:

During assembly, ensure to:

- Take care during assembly and in use, particularly when lifting or stretching and when using tools
- Wear appropriate safety clothing – protective gloves and footwear are recommended
- Build on a suitable level floor, which is strong enough to support the load and allow adequate working space
- Dispose of packaging materials responsibly



Warning:

Rules for the safe use of shelving:

- Ensure these instructions are retained for reference and that users are aware of the rules for safe use
- Never climb on the structure or stand on the shelves
- Do not lean or support ladders, steps, or other objects against shelving
- Always use safety steps to reach high shelves
- Do not use in damp or wet conditions
- Load heavy items on the lower shelves and lighter items on the higher shelves
- Ensure that the maximum load carrying capacities are not exceeded
- Please refer to the loading information supplied for details
