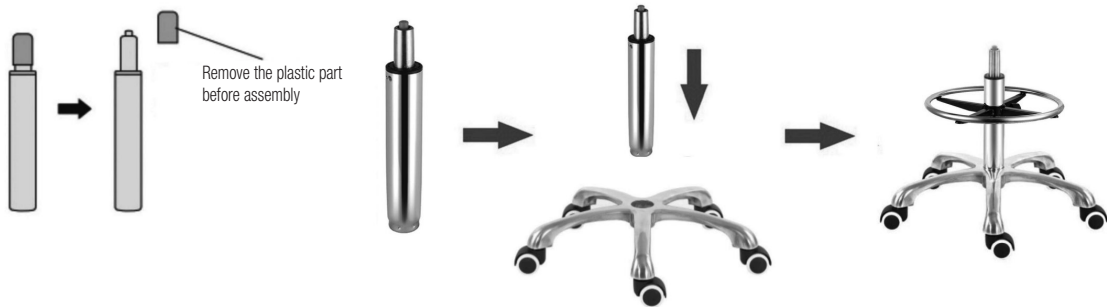
During assembly do not tighten bolts until all components are aligned properly, then tighten fully.

If you have any missing components please take note of the part name and contact your supplier.

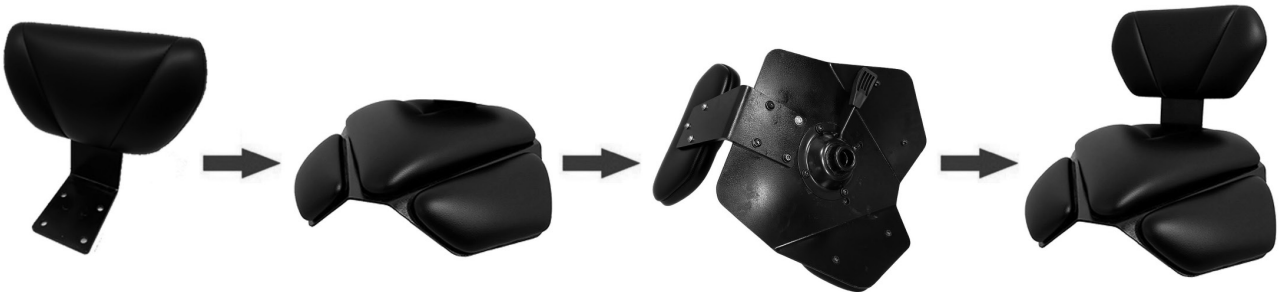
Seats are safe when used responsibly. If in doubt, contact the supplier.



1 Press five castors **A** or feet into the five star base **B**.



2 Remove the plastic cap. Put the gas lift **C** into the hole of the base **B**. Install the footrest **D** (footrest available to purchase separately.)



3 Install the backrest **F** on the seat **G** with four bolts.



4 Install the seat **F** and backrest **G** on the gas lift **C**.
