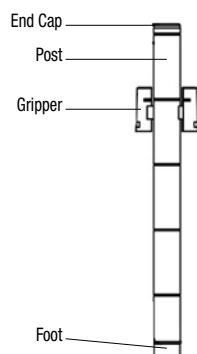


Assembly Sheet

STAINLESS STEEL SHELVING

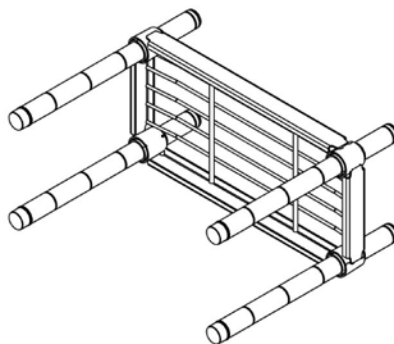
SHELVING



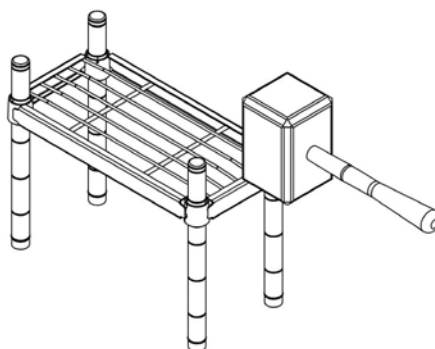
- 1** Clip the split grippers together so that the ridge on the inside is in line with the groove in the post, narrow part to the top, wide part to the bottom.



- 2** Clip together as shown.

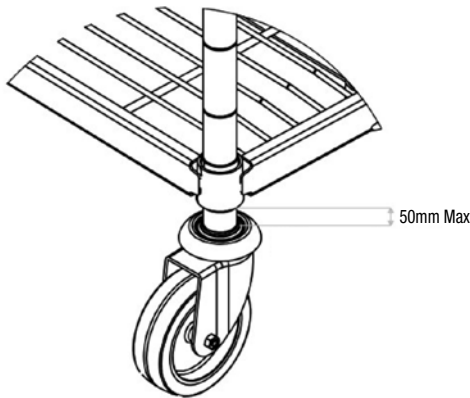


- 3** Place the shelf on its' side and slide the posts through the corners of the shelf, to the gripper.



- 4** Place the unit upright and gently tap the channel at the corners using a rubber headed mallet, whilst supporting the base of each gripper to fix in position.

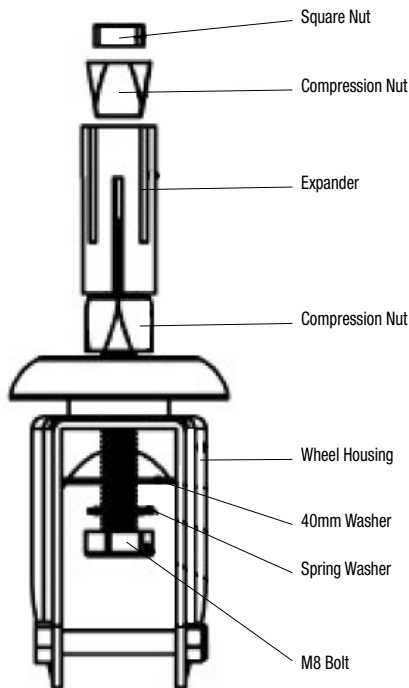
Castors

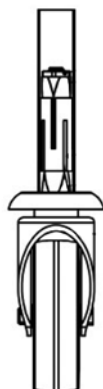
Castors only to be used to move shelving for cleaning, they are not trolleys.

NOTE: On mobile units the base of the gripper must be within 50mm of the lower end of the post not shown at 50mm for clarity.

- Place 40mm washer in housing, then the spring washer
- Push the M8 bolt through the holes in the spring washer, 40mm washer and wheel housing
- Place the first compression nut over the M8 bolt so the slope is the same as the diagram
- Place the expander over the bolt onto the compression nut
- Place the second compression nut over the M8 bolt and into the expander
- Thread the square nut onto the bolt and compression nut so that the square nut sits into the second compression bolt
- Turn the square nut and compression nut until they are snug and can be placed into the tube
- Place into the tube and tighten with the head of the M8 bolt, until all parts are held together on the M8 bolt as shown

- Once the unit is assembled as per "expander assembly instructions" place the castor in the tube as shown
- Use the bolt underneath to tighten against the square nut at the top
- The two compression nuts will travel towards each other causing the expander unit to squeeze tight against the inside of the tube and hold unit in place

- Do not lean or support ladders, steps, or other objects against shelving
- Always use safety steps to reach high shelves
- Load heavy items on the lower shelves and lighter items on the higher shelves
- Ensure that the maximum load carrying capacities are not exceeded
- This product is designed for hand loading
